

President's Report for the 2015 Annual General Meeting

1. **Community Environment Alliance**

SBEA is now a member of this alliance and has registered its interest in the purchase of solar panels in the nursery.

Progress for obtaining quotations is slowed down due to capacity check of transformers by Powercor.

Currently 52 residents are interested. Feed in rate to be set at 6.2 cents /kwh.

2. **Constitution changes**

Several meetings were held to decide on changes to the Constitution. These changes will be put to the meeting:

Life Membership, an additional membership category recognising valuable and outstanding service to SBEA.

Patrons, an additional membership category providing for members to sign up for 20 years membership of SBEA.

Nursery, changes to the Constitution covering the role of the Queenscliffe Community Indigenous Plant Nursery within SBEA.

3. **Queenscliff Public Cemetery**

A letter of support has been sent to the new manager of the Lonsdale cemetery. Through the Nursery we are providing indigenous plants for the Cemetery and collecting seed for the preservation of our special local flora.
